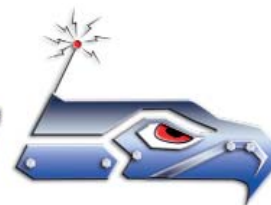

**Champion's** – This award recognizes a team that embodies the FLL experience, by fully embracing our Core Values while achieving excellence and innovation in both the Robot Game and Project.

**Robot Design** – Judges look for teams whose work stands out for its innovation, and dependability.

**Project Award** - Team whose quality research, innovative solutions, and creative presentation best reflects an in-depth understanding of the various scientific disciplines and issues involved with this year's Challenge Project.

**Core Values** - FLL presents this award to the team that demonstrates exceptional partnership, and the utmost respect to its teammates and its support and encouragement of fellow teams.

**Judges' Award** – Many high quality teams do not exactly fit the mold for an existing award, but nonetheless deserve recognition. Some teams have a story that profoundly sets them apart in a unique way. Sometimes a given award is just too close to call. This award gives the judges the freedom to recognize the most remarkable teams for which a standard award does not exist.

**Team Spirit** – This award goes to the team that most enthusiastically demonstrates a commitment to getting others to see how accessible, fun, and rewarding science and technology can be, especially when you are part of a great team.
